How will this program help specialists and medical practices?

- Specialists who are not currently practising medicine and wish to return to the workforce, may be provided with mentor and other support and assisted to undertake a clinical placement as part of an individually tailored refresher program.
- Practices that host a participant in the program will receive financial support.

Who is Eligible?

All speciality areas will be eligible, in co-operation with the relevant specialist medical colleges. A separate program has been developed for GPs.

The program aims to assist those Fellows of recognised Australian specialist colleges or who have been recognised as fully equivalent to an Australian trained specialist, who are registered on an Australian Medical Board register and who want to resume clinical practice after having taken a break.
